



Street Survey Results

Shardlow and Great Wilne Parish Council – Parish Plan Community Consultation

This document provides the results relating to the street survey pop up displays undertaken by Shardlow and Great Wilne Parish Council to identify key issues relating to the production of a detailed web based survey for the production of a parish plan

Introduction

Two street survey displays were held at Shardlow on Saturday 26th June and Sunday 27th June from 8 am until 6 pm. Residents were asked to record on a postcard three positive aspects about the parish and three areas of concern or things to improve about the parish.

Headline results

Ninety-six post cards submitted by residents across two street survey pop up displays. This represents a 6.4% response rate from a total parish population of circa 1500.

Postcards for dwelling included 84 house, 0 holiday home, 0 boat and 12 not disclosed.

The 41-60 age group was the highest age group to respond to the street survey with 39 (41%) postcards submitted followed by the 60+ age category with 30 (31%) postcards.

A total of 497 comments were received in total from respondents:

- 225 (45%) comments were received relating to positive aspects about the parish
- 272 (55%) comments were received relating to areas of concern or things to improve in the parish
- Fourteen residents provided no positive comments
- Two residents provided no areas of concern or aspects to improve

Some respondents did not manage to scribe three positive and three negative points. However, others scribed more than three points onto the postcard. All results have been counted despite the three-point preferred requirement. Sometimes residents scribed a couple of points within the same sentence and therefore these have been analysed and organised according to the first point stated within the full results. Please note that all results have been recorded 'word for word' below.

The top five recorded positive aspects about the parish included:

1. Community spirit, neighbourliness and cohesion
2. Countryside, rural environment, green space, wildlife
3. Pubs and restaurants
4. Litter management, overall cleanliness, maintenance
5. Character, heritage and history

There were 27 key issues identified as areas of concern or things to improve with the top 10 recorded as follows.

1. Community activities and events
2. Speeding and traffic noise
3. Lady in Grey
4. Village hall
5. Grocery shop
6. Flooding and drains
7. Housing, developers, land use and protection of green space
8. Bins
9. Soft landscaping
10. Pavements, pathways and footpaths

FULL RESULTS

Responses by dwelling type

A total of 96 postcards were submitted by residents over the two days the pop-up street survey took place. This included 84 (87.5%) from those living in houses and 12 (12.5%) not disclosing their type of dwelling.

Positive aspects of the parish

The top five recorded positive aspects about living in the parish or village out of a total of 21 different areas identified included:

1. Community spirit, neighbourliness and cohesion (59 comments, accounting for 26% of all positive comments made)
2. Countryside, rural environment, green space, wildlife (33 comments, accounting for 15% of all positive comments made)
3. Pubs and restaurants (22 comments, accounting for 10% of all positive comments made)
4. Litter management, overall cleanliness, maintenance (17 comments, accounting for 8% of all positive comments made)
5. Character, heritage and history (15 comments, accounting for 7% of all positive comments made)
